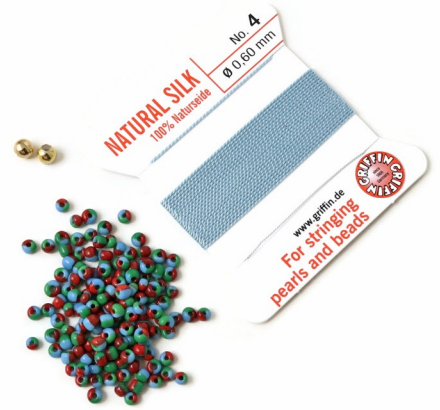


DIY Bracelet with adjustable clasp bead



Materials:

- Silk cord 0.60mm (SKU: 21021-0.6mm)
- Seedbeads (SKU: seed27-8)
- 1 x locking bead 4mm (SKU: 4511Bfg-4mm)
- 1 x 4mm bead (SKU: 1702ssf-4mm)
- + glue (SKU: 31141-3g)



Start by unwinding the entire string. This type of silk cord has a built-in needle at one end.



Tie a knot approx. 3 cm from the end of the string. Next, place a bead on the string. This is the end-bead.



Then pull the needle through the locking bead.



Pull the bead and the locking bead all the way down to the knot and tie another knot approx. 10cm from the first knot.



Start by pulling the desired number of beads on the thread.



When the bracelet has the desired length, tie a knot close to the last bead.



Now pull the needle back through the locking bead.



Then further back through the end bead.



You now have a locking bead and an end-bead placed on the bracelet.



Finally, tie a knot with both strings, some distance from the beads. Give the knot a little glue. Cut off the excess string.
