DIY | Creative pearl jewelry



Materials

Wire: 21020-0,6mm
Beads: seed18-8
Clasp: 3154fg-10mm
jumpring: 4565-4mm
cord ends: 4406fgmes
stone beads: 12531E-mix
freshwater pearls: 10140-6mm
chain extender: 4469fgst





Start by tying two tight knots at the end of the thread. Pull the needle through the hole in the middle of the knot shield.



If necessary, put some glue on the knot before closing the knot shield.



Pass the desired beads on the thread.



When the necklace has the desired length, pass the thread through the other crimp cord end.



Tie a knot and place the knot very close to the knot shield (a pair of pointed tweezers can be helpful).



Put some glue on the knot and carefully close the knot cover.



Fold the hook end together to form an eye.



Secure the clasp with a 4mm closed jumpring (The loop can be omitted and the lock inserted directly into the hook for simpler mounting).



At the other end, a 4mm loop is attached to the bent hook.



A chain extender can be inserted to adjust the length of the necklace or bracelet.
