

DIY Peyote stitch tubes



Materials:

- delicate gold 6k # 11 (SKU: DBC0-0034V)
- delica green # 11 (SKU: DB0663V)
- 1 pair of earring 12cm (SKU: P4023fg-12cm)
- 1m fireline, black 6lb (SKU: 21020-6lb)
- + beading needle (SKU: 31140-0.4mm)



Put 12 beads on the thread. The end thread should be approx. 10cm long. Now add the beads 1 at a time.



Put 1 golden bead on the needle and go back through the 2nd last golden bead.



Tighten the thread and place the beads as shown in the picture.



Insert 1 green bead on the needle and go back through the 2nd last green bead.



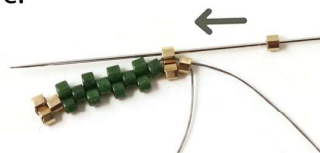
Tighten the thread and place the beads as shown in the picture.



Continue skipping 1 bead and putting adding 1 bead at a time.



Add the last golden bead and tighten. Turn the piece around.



Add 1 golden bead to the needle and pull it through the 1st golden bead that sticks up.



Add 1 green bead on the needle and go through the 1st green bead that sticks up.



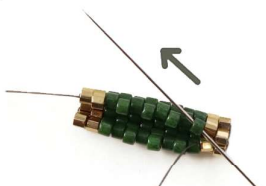
Continue in the same way to fill in the "holes" with 1 bead at a time. Flip the piece after each row.



When there are 5 beads at each end, the tube should be shaped. Pass the needle through the outer golden bead, as shown in the picture.



Tighten. Now insert the needle through the 2nd last golden bead on the opposite side. (it sticks up a bit)



Continue sewing through the beads that protrude, alternately, from side to side.



Sew the end by passing the thread back through 4 to 5 beads. Do the same with the end thread.



Finish the earring by gluing one pin down into the tube.
